	<p>Only after completing full registration (including uploading all attachments properly) and preparing Learning Agreement ONLY for ONE semester in his university system for international exchange Student will receive information about acceptance.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">DO NOT BUY PLANE TICKETS UNTIL YOU GET MAIL ABOUT ACCEPTANCE TO AWF</p> <p style="text-align: center;">We accept arrivals no later than one week after the start of the semester.</p>
<p>Learning Agreement</p>	<p>The Learning Agreements should be created based on offer of courses provided in English for Erasmus Students: Courses offered</p> <p>Students are supposed to prepare digital Learning Agreements in their home university system for Erasmus Without Papers - ONLY for ONE semester.</p> <p>The Learning Agreement should be prepared for single semester only. If a Student is nominated for whole year, should prepare the Learning Agreement for second semester later in term of recruitment for Spring semester.</p> <p>Please make sure that you find proper semester in the table. You can consult content of the courses with Faculty Coordinators directly.</p> <p>Also, the Faculty Coordinators' names should be written in the Learning Agreements - they are Persons Responsible in receiving institution.</p> <p>The number of subjects or ECTS points from a given field of study determines the field of study that the Student must choose and enter in the Learning Agreement.</p>
<p>Courses</p>	<p>AWF Warsaw offers courses in English, with English support (practical sport disciplines) and in Polish. We can offer you an individual path of study using materials and the helpful assistance of our English speaking teachers and students. Also, it is our custom that Erasmus Students are allowed to take any course (from any level and any faculty) as long as it is accepted by the Faculty Coordinator in home university. We have introduced limits of ECTS from incoming students. The minimum number of ECTS to be accepted to AWF is 25 (apart from Winter camp), the maximum is 35 in a semester.</p> <p>Courses will be opened according to the demand of Students, but if the minimum number of Students registered to a course is lower than 5, the course <u>will not be</u> opened.</p>



Winter camp	Students who would like to take part in Winter camp need to stay longer, usually Winter camp is organized on the last week of January. Students cover costs of their participation in the Winter camp (approx. 250 EUR) and are obligated to be provided with winter sports clothes and insurance.
Languages skills required	Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education requires B2 level of English language command from Erasmus students.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation	<p>AWF offers places in our dormitory (in double rooms) in our campus in two dorms. In order to book a place in a dormitory, a student needs to answer question about accommodation in application. There are no additional applications needed. The allocation of places is done according to a faculty/field of study in AWF. Once a student receives a place in our dormitory, he can use it as long as the semester lasts. The rooms are at student's disposal not earlier than 5 days before and after the term of semester.</p> <p>Costs of accommodation in "Męski" or "Żeński" Dormitory on the AWF Warsaw campus – monthly cost of a place in double room in each dorm during academic year 2025/2026 is 750 PLN (approx. 180 EUR) and costs of deposit is 700 PLN (app.165 EUR). The deposit is refunded in full at the end of the semester unless there are deductions for damages. <i>The costs of accommodation for the next year can be raised before the new academic year begins.</i></p> <p>The dormitory provides kitchen. Our guest-students should have things for personal use and own dishes. Students who will be accommodated in AWF dorms are obligated to open bank accounts in a bank in Poland in order to pay for accommodation and to receive their deposit back in Polish currency (PLN).</p>

HEALTH INSURANCE

ERASMUS student must have an accident and health insurance valid for whole mobility in Poland – students can not study nor attend the classes unless they are insured!	
Citizens of the EU/EEA	Students should bring an European health insurance card with them. Also an additional private insurance is recommended
Citizens of non-EU/EEA	Students are required to have their own private medical insurance. More information can be found on The National Health Fund website .
Students of Rehabilitation Faculty	Required: Virus Carrier State Test, Viral Hepatitis Vaccination;
Students of Rehabilitation Faculty for practical courses in a clinic	Required: Virus Carrier State Test, Viral Hepatitis Vaccination, Third Party Insurance, Personal and Occupational Accident Insurance. Hospital clothes and footwear required (uniforms or aprons).
Students attending Winter camp	Required: insurance for sport accidents is required

TEMPORARY RESIDENCE PERMIT /VISA REQUIREMENTS

Citizens of the EU/EEA	No visa is required from the EU/EEA member countries. A valid travel document entitles students to enter Poland. Temporary residence permit is fixed by the dormitory authorities so that it is important to fix the registration formalities at the dormitory right after arrival.
Invitation letter (for non - EU students)	Invitation letters are prepared after receiving required documents and accepting the Learning Agreement by a Faculty Coordinator.
Citizens of non-EU/EEA	All citizens of non-EU/EEA member countries who wish to study in Poland are required to obtain a Polish visa prior to their arrival. They should contact the Polish Consulate or Embassy in their country of residence.
Visa requirements and application forms as well as the complete list of Polish diplomatic missions abroad are available at www.msz.gov.pl . Persons who have received a visa for the whole period of stay in Poland are not obliged to apply for a residence permit.
