Situated on the southern coast of Cyprus, Larnaka is well-known for its beautiful clean beaches, great food, and vibrant nightlife. It is the perfect location for a great student life and experience.

It's just 15 minutes drive from Larnaka's International Airport to the campus of UCLan Cyprus. A regular bus service is available from the city centre to the campus and vice versa.

Ayia Napa is east from Larnaka and is very famous for its sandy beaches and clear blue waters and of course, its vibrant nightlife in the summer season. Ayia Napa also hosts many restaurants, featuring both local and international cuisine.

THINGS TO DO

Outdoor activities are very common in Larnaka due to the fantastic Mediterranean climate. Water sports, swimming, snorkeling, fishing, walking, cycling and many other activities are available to students.

Interestingly, the crystal clear bays are unusually rich in underwater wreckages for you to explore. There are many qualified and licensed diving instructors and businesses along the beach areas. Inland, there are many historic churches, archaeological sites, museums, galleries, gardens and other tourist attractions. The most notable are probably the Larnaka Fort, built in 1625 on the seafront



and St Lazarus Church built in the 9th century. Natural sites for wildlife and beauty include the Salt Lake on the outskirts of Larnaka, a haven for migratory birds, including flamingos and other waders.

Horse riding, nature walks, camel rides and organised excursions are also available. Alternatively, our more adventurous students can enjoy a day trip inside or outside Larnaka by hiring bikes or quad bikes.

Enjoy your meal, coffee or drink at Makenzy, Phinikoudes, Dhekelia or City Centre, all located within a relatively short distance from the University. Larnaka's Metropolis Mall offers a wide range of shops and restaurants where you can spend your free time or even your break between classes.




#UCLanians have access to a wide and practical range of Student Support Services, such as:

**AT THE CUTTING EDGE
OF TECHNOLOGY**



The University of Central Lancashire Cyprus is set in a modern, purpose-built University campus with state-of-the-art academic and operational facilities.

It incorporates all of what Audio Visual (AV) has to offer in education, but also in the ever-growing professional communication world, such as distance learning facilities, high-end presentation solutions and innovative multi-use spaces.

Students learn in meticulously designed lecture theatres, specialised labs, a moot court room, lecture rooms equipped with smart podium screens and interactive boards, seminar rooms and accommodating teaching spaces. Individual and group study spaces allow students to work alone or collaborate on projects.

Our IT infrastructure provides more than 300 software applications, loan of laptops, and free Wi-Fi across the campus. UCLan Cyprus has also won the sought-after title of the 'Most InAVative Education Facility' at the prestigious Europe, Middle East and Africa (EMEA) InAVation Awards, and triumphed over 30 competitors, as well as shortlisted projects from four other University finalists based in England, the Republic of Ireland and Russia.

Audio-visual highlights include smart podium monitors in every classroom, which allow presenters to annotate or draw freehand onto a projected display without the need for a whiteboard and pens.

A video conferencing system allows live streaming, while the entrance foyer video wall is capable of displaying content up to four times full HD video.

Students have the opportunity to study in an environment that suits them, whether it is in the welcoming library or in social areas around the campus.

All online facilities can be accessed off campus and anywhere in the world through the internet.

LIBRARY

The Library provides a comfortable, flexible working environment, boasting a student portal leading to all online resources, access to 300,000 UK and Cyprus e-books and e-journals. It offers a wealth of excellent learning resources, extensive collections of information sources and expert support from our Library team.

In addition to these thousands of books, audio-visual materials and journals, the Library also provides self-service issue and return facilities, online library catalogues, a silent study room and training PC labs with a laptop loan scheme available to all students.

MOOT COURT

UCLan Cyprus is the first University in Cyprus to have its own Court Room. It has been designed to reproduce not only the look and effect of a real court room, but also court rooms of the future.

Fully IT and AV-equipped, with both counsel and judge able to portray their evidence, representations and remarks onto three large projector screens, the Moot Court Room is ideal to be used for practice, training, debating, interviewing, negotiation, advising and arguing.


SPORTS LAB

The University of Central Lancashire Cyprus Sports Lab incorporates the latest technological advancements in the sport and exercise fields. In addition to its teaching activities, the UCLan Cyprus Sports Lab provides a full range of tests, metrics and exams to athletes of all abilities and sports, from beginner to professional levels, including ergometric tests delivered by accredited Sport and Exercise Scientists.

COGNITION & DEVELOPMENT PSYCHOLOGY LAB

An innovative lab for all Psychology students following the strict guidelines of the British Psychology Society (BPS). The Cognition & Development Lab of the University of Central Lancashire Cyprus is second to none and includes a dedicated student area, offering a unique experience on real case studies and psychological experiments, a conference area, which accommodates guest lectures from professionals of the industry, and a child observation suite with a one-way mirror.





The live recording room features autocue equipped UHD/4K studio cameras on broadcast specification pedestals. The control room contains a full complement of digital vision equipment including video manipulation, tapeless recording, graphics software and a multi-channel digital audio mixer.

MAC LAB

The Mac lab is an essential resource designed to foster creativity, technical skills, and professional development. The space is equipped with high-performance Mac desktops, optimized for graphic design, video editing, digital illustration, animation, fashion design and multimedia production.

The Mac computers feature industry-standard software such as Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Illustrator, Premiere Pro, After Effects), Final Cut Pro, Logic Pro, and 3D design tools like Blender, Cinema 4D and CLO | 3D. These powerful tools allow students to work on high-resolution projects with ease, ensuring that they can handle professional-grade tasks like video rendering, graphic design, garment design and audio production without any technical bottlenecks.

Using this lab is an opportunity for students to familiarise themselves with industry-standard software and hardware, preparing them for careers in creative industries such as digital media, media production, animation, graphic design, film, and audio production. The lab is designed to mimic professional working environments, making the transition from academia to the creative industry smoother.

ENGINEERING LABS

Engineering Laboratories support the BEng (Hons) Electrical & Electronic Engineering programme. The Electronic Engineering lab is equipped with workbenches and all the necessary state-of-the-art equipment (oscilloscopes, signal generators, probes, analysers, etc.), computers and machinery for students to practice in Electronic Circuits, Digital Electronics, Telecommunications, Microprocessors, Sensors, Programmable Logic, Robotics etc. The laboratory offers a unique hands-on experience for the students which involves all the steps of building electronic systems such as the design, the simulation, the prototyping and the testing.

The Electrical Engineering Lab is intended to emulate a real domestic and/or industrial setting in which students can perform an electrical installation and have a unique hands-on experience in wiring, circuit boards, AC and DC motors, generators, renewable energy sources etc. The lab is also equipped with Electromechanical Training Systems for practical work on Power Systems on topics such as Power Generation, Power Transmission and Power Consumption.

MEDIA STUDIO

Our UHD/4K ready, broadcast standard Media Studio, provides our students with multiple opportunities to be creative, producing a body of work that showcases the breadth of their diverse craft skills.

It provides access to state-of-the-art TV and Media Production technologies and equipment required for the production of high-quality Broadcast, TV, Radio and Digital Media audiovisual content. It is a highly flexible environment where all audio and video feeds can be configured via hardware and software routing.

SEWING STUDIO

The sewing studio is a specialised lab dedicated to housing essential equipment and supplies such as papers, fabrics, drawing supplies, sewing supplies, fabric cutters and more. The following equipment is available in the sewing studio:

- Flatbed industrial sewing machines
- Thread Overlock Machines
- Thread Interlock Machines
- Industrial Steam Iron
- Industrial Buttonhole Machine
- Consumables (such as patron, pins, scissors, needles, threats, fabrics, tailors chalk, measuring tapes, selection of zips / buttons, metre rules, masking tape, etc).

ATELIER

The Atelier has been designed as a spacious room dedicated to housing essential fashion design equipment and supplies such as papers, fabrics, drawing supplies, paper guillotines, fabric cutters, drawing boards, tracing/design light boxes/boards and more.

The interior design of the Atelier is intentionally distinct from a conventional classroom, exuding an atmosphere that ignites students' creativity. Designated areas in the room cater to different activities like drawing, sketching, fabric cutting and group brainstorming. Large solid tables at the correct height for pattern cutting are prominently placed in the room, allowing ample space for unrestricted artistic expression. Surrounding these desks are mannequins, comfortable stools, movable mirrors, ensuring an ideal fashion design work environment. Appropriate lighting has been thoughtfully integrated into the Atelier, creating an ambiance that enhances the creative process. The Atelier's flexible layout facilitates easy movement of furniture and equipment, offering versatility for various fashion design projects.



DESIGN STUDIO

The Design Studio has been meticulously crafted to accommodate the design-related programmes. It has a spacious layout with an additional storage room dedicated to housing essential design equipment and supplies such as papers, fabrics, drawing supplies, sewing supplies, paper guillotines, fabric cutters, drawing boards, tracing/design light boxes/boards and more.

The interior design of the studio is intentionally distinct from a conventional classroom, exuding an atmosphere that ignites students' creativity. Designated areas in the room cater to different activities like drawing, sketching, hand sewing and group brainstorming. The design studio also emphasizes collaborative learning, offering open workspaces where students can brainstorm, share ideas, and work on group projects.

Natural and artificial lighting have been thoughtfully integrated into the studio, creating an ambiance that enhances the creative process. The studio's flexible layout facilitates easy movement of furniture and equipment, offering versatility for various design projects.

The design studio stands as a testament to a thoughtfully designed space that encourages the growth and artistic exploration of its occupants.

Our partnership with ACCA attractively positions UCLan Cyprus as the 1st University in Europe offering a BA (Hons) Accounting and Finance Programme simultaneously accredited by ACCA, and offering an Accelerate status by exempting, upon registration to the programme, the first 9 fundamental courses, enabling the students to proceed to the rest of the 5 professional courses for the completion of the ACCA certification, giving you the opportunity to complete both the Bachelor's degree and the ACCA professional qualification, in just 4 years.

A great milestone for our BA (Hons) Accounting & Finance alumni Filippou Ioannou, who successfully managed to pass 2 out of the 5 professional modules of the ACCA Certification while completing his Bachelor's degree at UCLan Cyprus, gaining significant advantage upon his graduation.

ACCREDITATION BY BRITISH PSYCHOLOGY SOCIETY (BPS)

The BSc (Hons) Psychology degree is accredited by the British Psychological Society (BPS). This accreditation marks the UCLan Cyprus as the only University in Cyprus offering an accredited Psychology programme by the BPS professional body. As a result, graduates are granted a unique competitive advantage by gaining the requirements for Graduate Basis for Chartered Membership of the Society (GBC), which is the first step to become a professional psychologist and be able to work even in the UK.

BSc (Hons) COMPUTING ACCREDITATION BY BRITISH COMPUTING SOCIETY (BCS)

Our BSc (Hons) Computing programme is accredited by the BCS. The BCS accreditation is a mark of assurance that the BSc Computing Undergraduate degree of UCLan Cyprus meets the standards set by the BCS and sets the graduates of UCLan Cyprus as highly skilled IT professionals. As a result, graduates who will be receiving a BSc Computing degree, will automatically gain accreditation as Chartered Information Technology Professionals (CITPs).

RECOGNITION BY THE CYPRUS TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC CHAMBER (ETEK).

The programmes of study BEng (Hons) Electrical and Electronic Engineering, BSc (Hons) Computing and BEng (Hons) Computer Engineering are recognised by the Cyprus Scientific and Technical Chamber (ETEK) and the graduates of these programmes are eligible to register to ETEK.

UCLAN CYPRUS PROUD ACADEMIC SUPPORTER OF GOLD GYMNASTICS CHAMPION ELIAS GEORGIU

UCLan Cyprus is a proud Academic supporter of Golden gymnastics Champion and BSc (Hons) Sport & Exercise Science student, Elias Georgiou. The athlete who made Cyprus proud as 16,000 spectators stood up and listened to Cyprus' national anthem at Birmingham Commonwealth Games.

BSc (Hons) SPORTS & EXERCISE SCIENCE STUDENT, CHRYSALLENI TRIKOMITI, AT THE BIRMINGHAM 2022 COMMONWEALTH GAMES

BSc (Hons) Sports & Exercise Science student Chrystalleni Trikomiti was once again in the Cyprus delegation of the Commonwealth Games, this time coaching Anna Sokolova in the sport of Gymnastics - Rhythmic helping her win two silver medals and one bronze medal. Chrystalleni participated in the 2010 Commonwealth Games in New Delhi, winning two gold medals, one silver and two bronze medals making her the only athlete who won 5 medals in such a big event.

LLB PROGRAMME RECOGNITION

The LLB at UCLan Cyprus is a degree that can provide you with the basis to undertake the next stage of training as a barrister (the Bar Professional Training Course) or in becoming a solicitor in England and Wales.

The LLB has also been recognised as a qualifying law degree by the Cyprus Legal Council and was recently re-validated by the Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education (CYQAA). Exclusive in Cyprus, LLB graduates from UCLan Cyprus shall obtain the same qualifying law degree, with identical rights, privileges and entitlements, as any LLB graduate from an English or Welsh university.

As a result, our graduates will have the opportunity to sit their professional law exams in London, for instance, without having to return to university in order to obtain a qualifying law degree first. During these challenging economic times, globally, it is important to know that an English qualifying law degree is accepted by (law) professional bodies in a number of different countries around the world, including Cyprus and other countries of the Commonwealth.

MSc DATA ANALYTICS UNIQUE PARTNERSHIP WITH SAS

The MSc Data Analytics programme at UCLan Cyprus is the only programme in Cyprus which offers the SAS Joint Certificate. Specifically, MSc Data Analytics graduates have the option to receive the SAS Joint Certificate in Business Intelligence and Data Mining in addition to their MSc award.

LLM AND CISI UNIVERSITY PARTNER

Specific modules of our Master of Law (LLM) programme lay the ground for certification by the Chartered Institute for Securities and Investments (CISI).



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

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The language of instruction and assessment for all programmes at UCLan Cyprus is English.

Applicants will be assessed on an individual basis, based on their country's academic qualifications and standards.

{ THE GENERAL MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS ARE:

UNDERGRADUATE APPLICANTS (BACHELOR'S DEGREES)

- > Apolytirion or High School Leaving Certificate or 96 A' Level points (new Tariff system) in relevant subjects.
- > Certified Proof of English Language knowledge to a score of at least IELTS 5.5 or equivalent according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

POSTGRADUATE APPLICANTS (MASTER'S DEGREES)

- > Bachelor's degree (at least Lower Second Class).
- > Certified Proof of English Language knowledge to a score of at least IELTS 6.5 or equivalent according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1 In case you still do not have your School leaving certificate (for Undergraduate applicants) or your Bachelor's degree (for Postgraduate applicants) you can provide the latest mark sheet you have and a conditional offer letter will be issued to secure your place.
- 2 In case you do not have an accredited English language qualification, we offer our recognised English language University Admissions test, called 'Password'.
- 3 Students whose native language is English or those who have completed their High School education in English or Bachelor's degree from a UK University, need to provide appropriate evidence, and the Admissions Department will advise them of their eligibility accordingly. This does not apply for International students.
- 4 International Students who will require a student visa must provide an official English language qualification such as IELTS, TOEFL, IGCSE/GCSE, Password, etc. If you are nationals of the following countries: UK, Ireland, USA, Canada (only if the language of teaching on High School or University is English), Australia or New Zealand, then you do not need to provide any English qualification.

TAKE OUR UNIVERSITY'S ENGLISH LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS TEST

Our University offers the Password test, which is an internationally recognised English Language University Admissions test, created by researchers involved in the development and validation of Language assessments such as IELTS and Cambridge suite.

The test can be taken online or at the UCLan Cyprus campus. In order to take the test, you need to inform our Admissions Office who will guide you how to prepare for it, and any steps you need to take in advance, such as the payment of the test fee.

— ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIPS

40% special scholarships on the original fees to UCLan Alumni and a 10% bursary on the advertised fee to their 1st degree relatives.

OTHER BURSARIES

— LARGE FAMILIES BURSARIES

Only for Locals/CY: Members of P.O.P.O. (3 children) are allowed 15% bursary on the advertised fee and members of P.O.P. (4 children or more) are allowed 20% bursary on the advertised fee, for the first year of study. For the next years, a 10% bursary annually is allowed, to both P.O.P.O. and P.O.P. members.

— SIBLINGS

10% bursary on the advertised fee for every year of study for all the siblings while studying simultaneously.

POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

30% scholarship on the original fees open to all postgraduate programmes, with a condition that the student passes successfully an interview with the Course Leader and/or Head of the School.

Important Note for Postgraduate Scholars

The postgraduate scholarship comes with a number of responsibilities and expectations; they should be exemplar scholars in both their behaviour and performance during class and modules on their postgraduate studies. In case of failure of passing any modules of their Postgraduate degree, the retake module fee will be calculated on the tuition fee that was applicable prior to the scholarship or discount earned.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

APPLYING FOR A STUDENT VISA

All non-EU students require a student visa to study at a University in Cyprus. Students must submit the visa documents to the University. The University will then submit, on behalf of the student, the visa documents/application to the Migration Authorities. You must adhere by the deadlines set to you by the Admissions Advisor guiding you in order to ensure your visa is issued on time.

Once you have your conditional offer letter from the University's Admissions Department, you will need to gather the below documents and follow the steps indicated by your Admissions Advisor.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1 The first deposit payment of €3000 (Three Thousand Euros) must be completed before the documents are submitted to the Migration Authorities for evaluation. The copy of the Bank Transfer must be provided in an email to the Admissions Department.
- 2 For your documents to be submitted to the Migration Authorities, you must complete the payment of the Visa Application Fee of €210 (Two Hundred and Ten Euros), non-refundable.
- 3 The estimated period for the Migration Authorities to evaluate an application, is minimum a month, from the day of submission.
- 4 All documents must first be sent via email to your Admissions Advisor in order to confirm that they are correct. Once you receive confirmation you can send the original documents via courier to the University.
- 5 Students must not travel to Cyprus until their visa is issued and sent to them by the University.

GENERAL VISA GUIDELINES

All documents will be evaluated by the Migration Department and the Ministry of Education. The decision will be communicated directly to the University and the Ministry of Education, Sport & Youth of Cyprus.

WHEN TRAVELLING TO CYPRUS

Upon arrival at Larnaka airport, students will be required to present to the Immigration Authorities the following:

1. Original passport
2. Copy of the Entry Permit (student visa)
3. Offer Letter by the University
4. Receipt of Payment of the Deposit to the University
5. Cash money minimum €2,000
6. Original Police Certificate

UPON ARRIVAL IN CYPRUS

The student visa, called entry permit, is valid for travelling to Cyprus and only for a limited number of days after arrival; therefore, it must be renewed immediately. Failure to do so, may result in cancellation of your student visa. More information can be acquired by contacting the Admissions Department at internationalvisacyprus@uclan.ac.uk

All students must open a Bank account with a local Bank and deposit a minimum of €1000. A UCLan Cyprus student registration letter, a Housing Contract (attested by Notary Public or the Community Council president), your passport and a copy of your Police Clearance certificate, should be presented to the bank when opening a bank account. Do not forget

to ask for a statement of the account once you have deposited €1000. All medical tests including the x-ray must be re-done once the student arrives in Cyprus.

VISA RENEWAL FEES

For the renewal and application of the Temporary Residence Permit (Pink Slip), the following (approximate) charges are applicable and payable to other Organizations / Authorities (not to the University):

1. Pink slip application fee €55
2. Medical Insurance €150
3. Medical tests €60 (once off)

MIGRATION REGULATIONS

According to the Cyprus authorities, students must attend their classes regularly. Students who do not register for an academic year will have to depart from Cyprus.


COST OF LIVING

OTHER FEES FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- International Commercial Mediation Module under LLM programmes: €350 per student.
- Graduation Fee: €50 for those participating in the graduation ceremony.
- Retake of a Module: €600 for every 10-ECTS module that needs to be retaken.

- APL Module Evaluation Fee: After the start of Academic Year, €100 per module evaluation request, regardless of the decision. Non-refundable.
- Official Transcript (final): Additional official copy requested: €5 per set. Certified Copy of Degree: €10 per set.
- Distance Learning Exams Fees: For physical exams, the University will indicate the nearest exam centre to your location in case you cannot come at the University campus. In case you will need to be accommodated to an exam centre/location and not at the University campus, then a Fee per Exam might be charged.
