VISA INFORMATION

EU National Students

For safety reasons, we suggest that EU Nationals register (yellow slip) to the Immigration Department and book an appointment in person.

- Students individually book an appointment at the corresponding department of Migration office of their city of residence in order to request a Yellow Slip.
- For the students who will stay in Nicosia city: please contact admissions@uclancyprus.ac.cy.

Students from a Third country who study in EU country

Upon completion of the period of study at UCLan Cyprus, the University does not have any responsibility towards the stay of the student and they have to return back to the country of origin. UCLan Cyprus will be informing migration that the Erasmus cycle has finished.

Ukrainian students

Can apply for the temporary protection program through the Migration/Immigration Department until the programme is available.

* Students visit the Migration Authorities in order to validate their status.

• If the students hold a valid residence permit of the EU country, they are studying they will send a copy to the Erasmus Office and they are allowed to stay in Cyprus for the period of their mobility.

• If they have a temporary protection in the EU country they are staying, they provide a copy to the Erasmus Office.

• If their residence permit of the EU country they are staying has expired they need to renew it OR request a VISA in Cyprus.
